What is Stewards of Children?

Steward of Children is a prevention training program that teaches adults how to prevent, recognize and react responsibly to child sexual abuse. It is the only nationally distributed evidence-based program proven to increase knowledge, improve attitudes and change child protective behaviors. It uses a practical, five-step approach to prevention and response that enables adults to protect the children in their lives.

The 2½ hour training is a mix between video and facilitator/participant discussion. Participants will meet survivors who lived through child sexual abuse, experienced its immediate and long-term effects, and ultimately were able to find healing. They will also meet experts who work with children and families and confront abuse on a daily basis. Lastly, they will find concrete steps that you can take to protect the children in their life.

It is designed for parents, family members and/or anyone who is or may be serving children in the future including (but not limited to): teachers, coaches, camp counselors, childcare providers, the faith community and/or anyone in the human services field.
